3. Vote for nonpartisan offices and ballot measures.

These votes will be counted, even if you do not mark a political party.

This vote approves, for up to seven years, regular property taxes higher than the limits in Chapter 84.55 RCW, beginning with 2005 total regular taxes limited to \$3.20/\$1,000 assessed value.
